WHAT THIS IS

The crisis of missing school.

Chronic absenteeism — **missing 10% or more of the school year** (about 18+ days) for any reason, excused or not — is one of the strongest warning signs of falling behind and dropping out. This reference gives **every state (plus D.C.) its own page** with its rate and national rank.

A PANDEMIC-ERA SURGE

Before COVID, about **15%** of students were chronically absent. That nearly doubled to a peak of **~31%** in 2021–22. It has since eased — the 2022–23 national rate was **27.8%** — but **no state has returned to its pre-pandemic baseline**. Rates run highest in urban districts and among students facing poverty, disability, or health barriers.

In 2022–23, about **27.8%** of U.S. public-school students — roughly **one in four** — were chronically absent, missing 18+ days of school. That’s nearly double the **15%** pre-pandemic rate.

The range is stark: from **16.7%** in New Jersey to **46.7%** in District of Columbia — a gap of 30 points. Twenty states saw more than 30% of students chronically absent. The pages that follow give the rate and rank for every state.
