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THE WORLD EDUCATION LIBRARY

This completes a set with our **World Education Atlas** (how systems work), **PISA Atlas** (test outcomes), and **World Literacy Atlas** — here, the simplest measure of all: how many years people actually spend learning.

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WHAT THIS IS

Two numbers, one story.

Every country's page shows two UNDP measures: **expected years of schooling** (how long a child starting school today can expect to stay) and **mean years of schooling** (how long adults 25+ actually did). The **gap** between them reveals whether education is expanding, holding, or stalling.

■ Expected (children today) ■ Mean (adults 25+)

READING THE GAP

Worldwide, a child today can expect **13 years** of schooling, while the average adult has completed **8.8** — a **4-year** jump across generations. A *wide* gap means schooling is rising fast; a *narrow* one means a mature system (rich countries) or one that has stalled (some low-income ones).

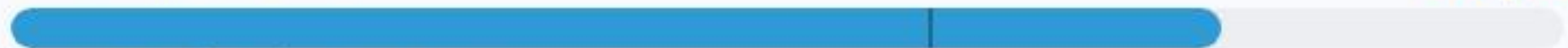

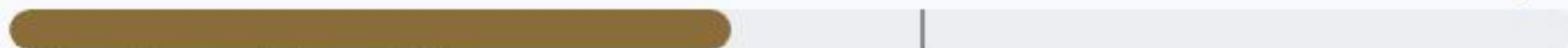

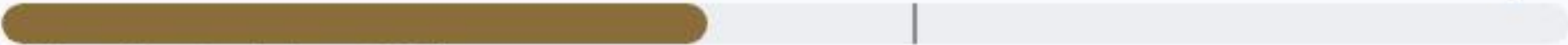

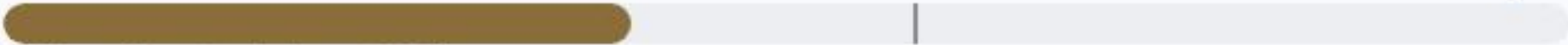

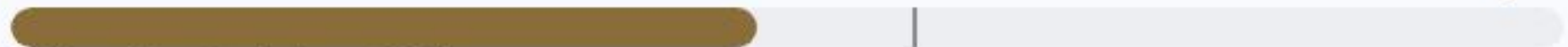

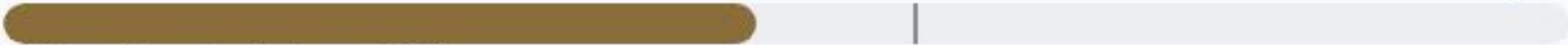

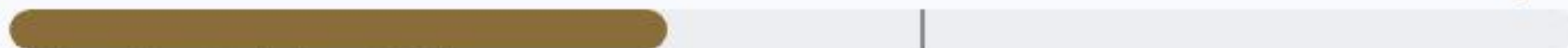

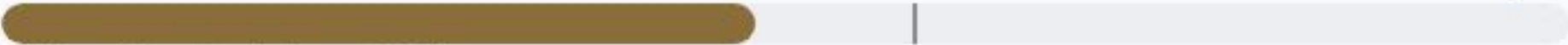

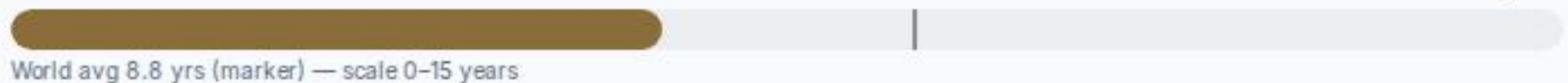

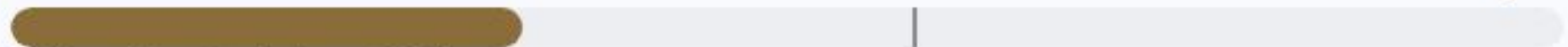

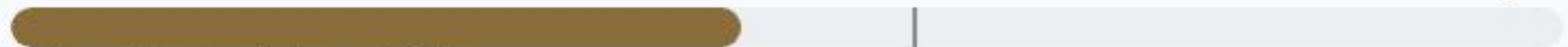

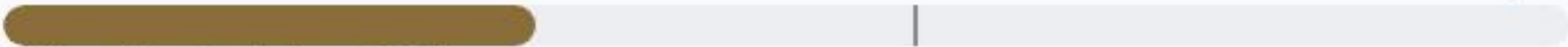

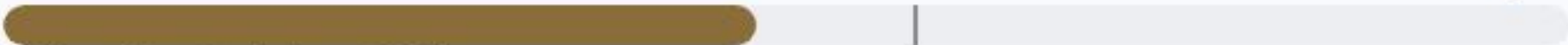

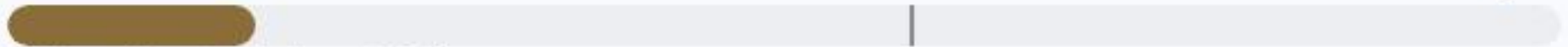

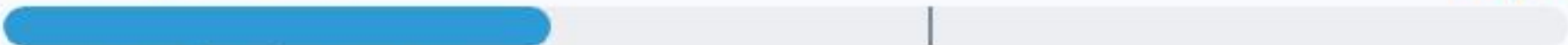

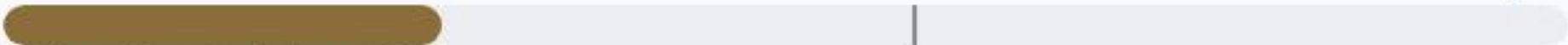

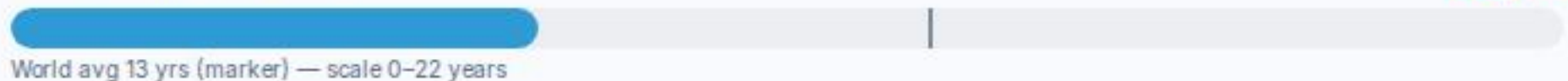

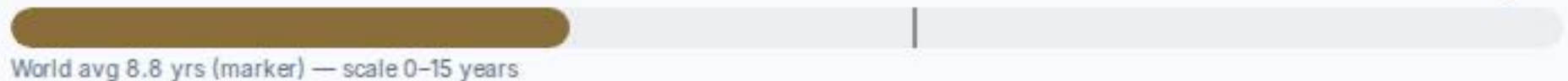

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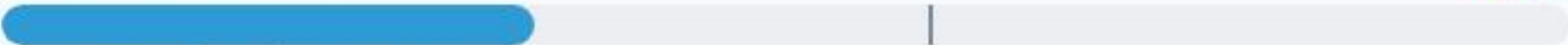

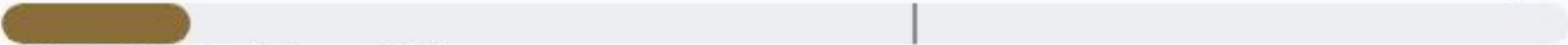

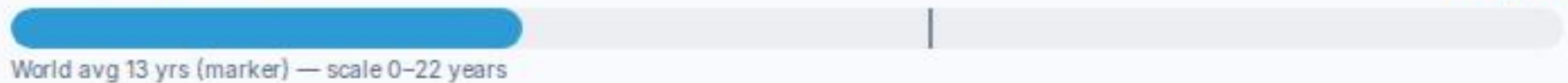

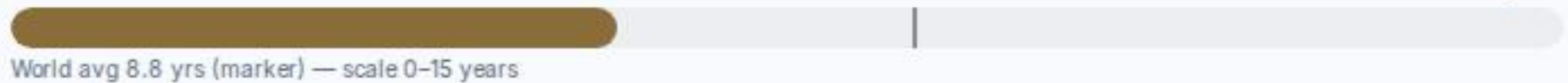

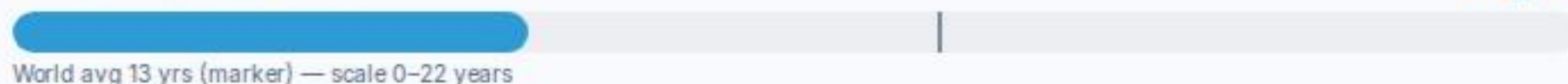

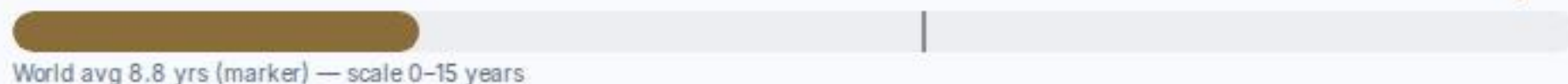

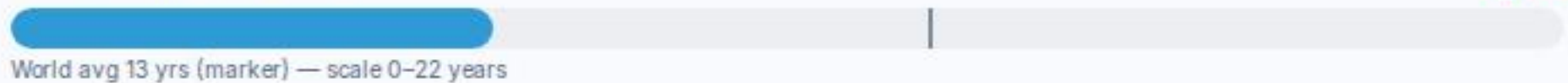

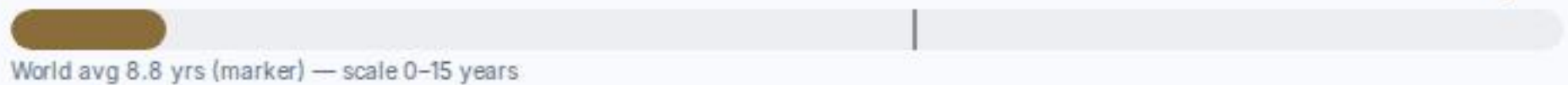

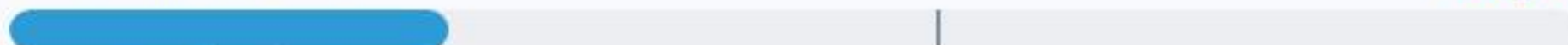

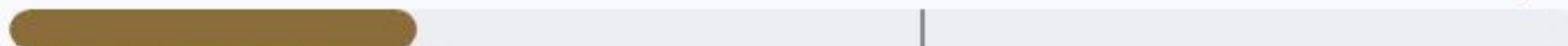

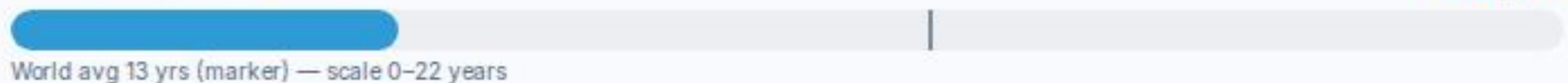

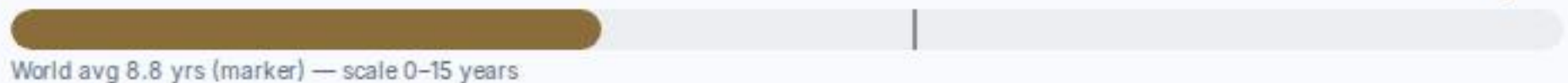
